Pennsylvania toughens rules for child car seats

As families head off to summer vacations, Pennsylvania parents need to know the new child car seat law that was signed by Governor Wolf on June 13, 2016. The previous law was too vague for parents with children under the age of two, it stated: "Children under 4 years old: Use a federally approved child car seat, appropriate for the height and weight of your child." The law did not state whether the car seat should be forward or rear facing. The new law requires a child under 2 years of age be securely fastened in a rear-facing child passenger restraint system, which is to be used until the child outgrows the maximum weight and limits designated by the manufacturer. This new law will take effect 60 days from when it was signed with verbal warnings for violators for the first year. After the first year violators of the law face fines of up to \$125 per offense. So this summer as you take your families on those long car rides to the shore, amusement parks and family visits lets protect our babies heads, necks and spines as they drive along the PA highways safely.
